The much-anticipated exhibition will serve as an important milestone for the duo. Having worked together since they were 20, *Gemini* marks 10 years of collaboration. Works in the exhibition will include both old and new works, demonstrating their interest in Descartes' mind-body split and dualism. Consciousness is not physical. When we encounter the world physically, these thoughts are registered phenomenally. David Chalmers attempts to unpack this "explanatory gap" between objective processes of the brain and subjective experiences. The Flemings' practice, often imbued with boy-ish humor and fun, find their origins within this divide. Between the cerebral and the physical, the artists attempt to collapse, expand, and merge ways of understanding. Information (while immaterial) is embodied in the physical because information is a property of the



us long for a deep connection with others? How does synergy unfold between separate individuals? How can you make transparent the invisible bonds that manifest through collaboration?"

Most importantly, the Flemings' strength often rests in delicate moments of sympathy, unique examples of their connection, underscoring the idea of soul mates, reminding us of our own universal desires to share experience. What is shared is what is real because there is no meaning if meaning is not communal.

*Jean-Luc Nancy's: "Being Singular Plural" posits that one cannot discuss existence (being) without discussing coexistence (being-with). One cannot fully understand their own existence without reflecting on their relationship to other living beings in a shared world. We are all reliant upon and bound to the communities in which we coexist.*
